- Departure date: October 29, 2017

AIBA Supervisor Course

- Arrival date: October 29, 2017
- Course dates: October 30 – 31, 2017
- Departure date: November 1, 2017

3. Eligible Applicants:

Supervisor Course

- Current AIBA Certified ITO, having participated in at least 3 AOB Competitions as an ITO.

ITO Course

- AIBA and/or Confederation Executive Committee Members.
- AIBA and/or Confederation Commission Members
- President, Secretary General or Elected Executive Members of AIBA NF
- Paid Employees of National Federation
- Former 3-Star R&Js with an exceptional past performance history
- AIBA can make exceptions for individuals with proven skills and knowledge of AIBA competitions.

4. Financial Terms and Conditions:

The applicants must cover the following expenses:

- Flights and Visa (those needing visa support will be charged an extra \$30 due in cash on site)
- Accommodations (costs covers 3 meals a day)
 - Double room - \$70 USD a day
 - Single room - \$90 USD a day
- Course Fee:
 - ITO - \$200 USD
 - Supervisor - \$300 USD

The costs have to be paid in advance: No applicants will be allowed to follow the course otherwise.
