Job Purpose

The IABA Ulster Branch are currently looking for dynamic individuals to join our team as Boxing Coaches to work part time hours, delivering high quality non-contact boxing sessions within schools in different locations across Northern Ireland (Derry/Londonderry, Strabane & Tyrone). The aim of the coach is to create and sustain links between schools and clubs, introduce non-contact boxing sessions to schools and children that will be new to the sport. The role contains significant engagement element, strengthening communication pathways and creating sustaining links between schools and clubs, coaches and volunteers.

Main Responsibilities

- Engage with at least 4 local schools to arrange a 6-week coaching programme between October – November 2023.
- Devise a 6- week progressive coaching plan to teach the basic core skills in boxing in a fun and structured environment.
- Lead, motivate and engage with the children and young people in your sessions.
- Demonstrate games and skills with enthusiasm and energy and provide positive feedback to the participants.
- Plan the sessions, ensure class start and finish on time, and engage with parents where possible.
- Abide by all IABA Policies and Procedures.
- Storing Equipment at Home.
- Completing session registers and providing weekly reports to the Club Development Officer
- Liaising with the schools that you make contact with.
- To enhance and increase the public profile of boxing.
- To undertake further training as required

- Completed Children and Young People Safeguarding Workshop within last 3 years.
- Full Driving Licence

Desirable

- IABA Level 2 Coaching Qualification or above.
- First Aid Qualified

Requirements – Experience

Essential

- A minimum of 2 years demonstrable experience of delivering boxing (either gained in a paid or voluntary capacity) to at least 1 of the following groups.
 - Women and Girls
 - Participants from areas of High Social Need
 - People with a disability
- Organising and setting up own sessions

Desirable

- Experience of carrying out monitoring and evaluating of programmes

Requirements – Knowledge

- Knowledge of coaching structures, club structures and competitive opportunities specific to boxing.
- A thorough knowledge of the role of physical activity in the promotion of an active lifestyle and the importance of physical activity for health and wellbeing.
- Understanding of the IABA's role in the development of boxing.
- Knowledge of IT including working with databases, spreadsheets, word processing and presentation packages

- Ability to organise, plan & deliver structured training sessions.
- Have an outgoing and dynamic personality.
- An ability to engage with children with energy, enthusiasm and excitement.
- Excellent organisational, verbal communication and listening skills.
- Good administrative skills

- Ability to work by yourself unsupervised and part of a team.
