## NATIONAL BOY/GIRL 1, 2 & 3 CHAMPIONSHIPS 2025

**Venue:** National Boxing Stadium, Dublin.

**Dates:** April 21<sup>st</sup> – 26<sup>th</sup>.

**Entries:** An entry fee of €15 applies. Boxers will be pre-entered by their Units from the weights they won at in their Unit Championships. Deadline for entries received by Stephen Connolly [registrar@iaba.ie](mailto:registrar@iaba.ie) and [sally@iaba.ie](mailto:sally@iaba.ie) is 12pm on Monday 14<sup>th</sup> April.

Any boxer beaten in their Unit championships but who was an Irish Champion at Boy/Girl 1 & 2 from 2024, is eligible for participation as the defending champion. Last years Champions can move up a weight, but can not move down a weight.

**Draws:** Tuesday, 15<sup>th</sup> April at 2pm

The draw is being conducted on the basis of pre-entry only.

### **Weigh-in and Medical:**

*Boxers will weigh only on the first and last day they box.*

Boxing Record books to be presented by the boxer at their initial weigh-in if not previously given to the IABA. Entry fee to be paid at the initial weigh-in.

**Weigh-in times:** In National Stadium from 8.00am - 9.00am

**Boxing:** 11am each day

**Duration of rounds:** Boys & Girls 3 x 1.5 Minutes

**Age Requirements:** Boxers born in 2011, 2012 and 2013.

**N.B.** It is a condition of entry that **all boxers and their clubs have signed and submitted the Members Acknowledgement Form** and it is the responsibility of the entering unit that this stipulation is complied with.



**Anti-Doping:** Boxers must provide details of any medication they are taking or have taken in the preceding 4 weeks. Anti-Doping may be carried out at any stage of the competition. Attention is called to the stipulation in the IABA Rule book that each boxer presented by his/her club shall be fit to box. This is the responsibility of the club.

**Coaches: Must be Registered via email: [secretary@iaba.ie](mailto:secretary@iaba.ie)**

Only registered coaches will be allowed to enter the field of play and enter the changing rooms. Coach registration will be cross-checked against Qualifications and Garda Vetting/Access NI checks. Any registered coaches who do not have current Garda Vetting/Access NI checks will not be permitted to sit at corner and/or to enter the changing rooms. Fundamental coaches will be permitted to do No. 2.

**Attire:** Coaches **must** wear tracksuits and runners in their corners at all sessions and endeavour to set a high standard of hygiene. **No Shorts, Caps or Hats are allowed.**


- **No international competition kits to be worn by any boxers; boxers may wear club kit, only.**
- **A club shall not include in its list of members the name of any person who is a member of any other club.**
- **Accordingly, clubs entered to the Championships affirms that the entrant is not a member of any other club, in any jurisdiction**

**Gumshields:** Red/Orange/Pink or variations of these colours are not allowed. Hair must be tied back, and swimming hats or hairnets should be worn under the headgear for boxers with long hair.

**Sportsmanship:** All decisions must be accepted in a sporting manner. Any complaints must be addressed to the Chief Official, Mr. Stephen Connolly. Please show respect to all Ringside Officials
