OPENING

The Board of Directors has extended its congratulations to Central Council, Ulster Boxing Council and Antrim County Board on their successful hosting and organisation of the superbly-run 2025 National Elite Competition. Boxing at the Girdwood Community Hub was of the highest standard, a testament to the commitment and skill of boxers, coaches and clubs throughout the Association. This competition staged with the invaluable support of Belfast City Council.

ELECTIONS UP-DATE

The Board has determined that no county or provincial elections will take place this year and all elections will, instead, take place in 2026. This is to bring the elections cycle back in to alignment with Central Council. On this basis, the terms of all sitting provincial offers is extended.

DISCIPLINE

The Board has resolved to form a Working Group to examine the Discipline structure within the Association, and to ensure that the highest possible cultural and ethical standards are up-held.
